he would take it out and take it to Richmond
I would write to you and get you to seal it
I want you to see him at once and see if
he had got it and seal it for me the amount
I think is 40 dollars I expect there is some interest
on it there is no Court on it I give nance
30 cents the Court of the warrant at the Court
house and write to me and let me no if he
had it I am sawy party truly
