And he let a graven image of the grone that hee had made, in the house, of which the Louis said to David, and to Solomon his some, "In this house, and in Jerusalem, which "1. King 8.29. I have cholen out of all tribes of Ilrael, will I and 9.3. chap.

put my Panie for euer.

8 Peither will I make the feete of Israel moone anymore out of the land which I gane their fathers: onely if they will observe to doe according to all that I have commanded them, and according to all the Law that my servant Moles commanded them.
